

## MILFORD FARMERS MARKET RULES 2014 revised

1. Products sold at this market are limited to those grown or made in New Hampshire. Exceptions can be made at the discretion of the Market members for products the members cannot provide.
2. 75% of the products sold must be grown or made by the vendor in New Hampshire. Buying in from non-member farms is discouraged unless there is insufficient product to meet customer demand, The Steering Committee will determine buy-in need.
3. Annual dues are to be determined each year at the annual meeting held at a mutually convenient time at the beginning of each year.
4. Market hours are Saturdays from 10:00 AM to 1:00PM at the Tractor Supply lot in the Granite Town Plaza on Elm St. Vendors must be set up by 9:30.
5. Market usually starts in June with member consensus and when enough farms have sufficient produce available. The market usually ends by mid-October or when farms are out of adequate produce to sell.
6. This market is not intended for unloading produce at below fair market value prices. Pricing is based on the "New Hampshire Weekly Market Bulletin" as a guide.
7. Vendors must start by mid-July and are expected to be present every Saturday until their produce is at the end of its season. Exceptions to this rule can be made with the agreement of the majority of the vendors/or Steering Committee. It is important that we support each other to make the Market a customer destination.
8. Vendors are expected to keep their spaces clean.
9. Vendors not coming to the market on Saturday MUST notify the Market Coordinator by phone the Friday before the market. Failure to notify the Coordinator may be grounds for termination.
10. Applications should be submitted by June 1st. Insurance and appropriate licenses must be submitted before the opening of the first Market. Each regular member will pay an annual membership fee of \$100.
11. The Market coordinators are encouraged to find guest vendors to add diversity to the Market. Guest vendors will pay \$15.00 each Market they attend and provide insurance and licenses.
12. Licenses will be obtained and displayed according to NH regulations.
13. There will be no live animals at the Markets.
14. The Steering committee has the right to terminate a vendor if they do not abide by the rules or the spirit of the Market.
